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
COMMITTEE RESOLUTION

that pursuant to title 40 U.S.C. § 3307, a prospectus providing for a repair and alteration project to remediate mold, eliminate water filtration, replace the building façade, and undertake system and site upgrades at the Pensacola District Courthouse located at 1 North Palafox Street in Pensacola, Florida, at a total cost not to exceed \$2,673,000 for design; \$25,259,222 for construction; and a management inspection cost of \$2,849,000, for a total estimated project cost of \$30,781,000, a description of which is hereto and by reference made part of this resolution, is approved.

Provided, that the Administrator shall not delegate to any other agency the authority granted by this resolution.
