that pursuant to title 40 U.S.C. § 3307, a prospectus providing for the acquisition of a site and the design and construction of a new U.S. Courthouse of approximately 243,000 gross square feet, including approximately 43 inside parking spaces, in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, for a total of \$168,444,000, a description of which is attached hereto and by reference made part of this resolution, is approved.
