#### **CALL TO ORDER**

Stephanie Hardison, Deputy Designated Federal Officer (DFO), opened the public meeting by welcoming the group before reminding the public that there would be time for comments and statements at the end of the meeting. ### **WELCOME & OPENING REMARKS**

Chairperson Kristin Seaver thanked everyone for attending today before reviewing the agenda. Farad Ali thanked the subcommittee members for attending today's meeting and is looking forward to the upcoming work the subcommittee has.

### SUBCOMMITTEE BUSINESS

Kristin reviewed what the subcommittee had planned for the upcoming weeks in preparation for the Full Committee meeting in May. She hopes to have a draft report by the end of today's meeting, along with key next steps to hit the subcommittee's benchmarks.

The subcommittee participated in a survey to select their topics for recommendations. The targeted solicitation to expand the supplier pool for climate and sustainability contractors had the most votes for recommendations. Creating industry networking to connect with the supplier pool and creating incentives for large businesses to assist small businesses in getting up to speed on climate and sustainability climate were both tied for second. Creating the sustainability and climate risk model for acquisition in the government marketplace was third place on the list of recommendations to create. The group moved to discuss the recommendation poll results and see if they should further narrow down the top four recommendations to two.

The group moved to re-rank the top four recommendation topics to select which two the group would focus on for now. The top two recommendations the group voted for are the following:

- Targeted solicitation to expand the supplier pool for climate and sustainability contractors.
- Creation of the sustainability and climate risk model for acquisition in the government marketplace.

For the following steps, the group broke into two groups to refine each recommendation and to come up with why they are recommending it, key stakeholders

for the recommendation, and other examples that have been successfully implemented that relate to the recommendation.
