What We Do

GSA delivers the best customer experience and value in real estate, acquisition, and technology services to the government and the American people. We provide centralized procurement for the Federal Government, offering billions of dollars worth of products, services, and facilities that federal agencies need to serve the public. We provide workplaces by constructing, managing, and preserving government buildings and leasing commercial space. Our acquisition solutions offer private sector professional services, equipment, supplies, telecommunications, and information technology to government organizations and the military. Our technology leadership helps agencies build, buy, and share technology in ways that support their missions to better serve the public. Our implementation of government-wide policies promotes management best practices and efficient government operations.

Who We Are

Powered by a lean workforce, GSA's Northwest/Arctic Region (Region 10) serves federal customers that represent more than 94,000 federal workers in Alaska, Idaho, Oregon, and Washington. With regional offices in 15 cities, GSA delivers services, innovation, and value to civilian and military agencies anywhere around the world or right next door. We work in design, real estate management, information technology, fleet, credit cards, travel services, supplies and services, and real and personal property disposal.

Public Buildings Service

PBS is the landlord for the civilian federal government. PBS acquires space on behalf of the federal government through new construction and leasing, and acts as a caretaker for federal properties across the country. With a

regional portfolio of 15 million square feet of owned and leased office space in the Region, PBS plays a major role in the commercial real estate market and makes a significant economic impact through annual rental payments.

PBS also uses the best 'green' building technology that industry offers to increase performance and decrease operating costs in government buildings. Through implementation of LED light, solar power, rainwater capture, biomass heating, geothermal, and other technologies, we reduce energy consumption in federal buildings.

Additionally, PBS serves as a careful steward of important historic government properties. Our portfolio includes 30 historic buildings including the National Historic Register's Pioneer U.S. Courthouse in Portland, Oregon.

Federal Acquisition Service

The Federal Acquisition Service (FAS) helps federal agencies buy goods, services, and technology solutions. In addition, FAS helps State, Tribal, and local governments in some circumstances. The Federal Government's buying power offers the best value for taxpayers and federal customers.

Professional Services & Human Capital Categories:	The Region is home to a large contingent of FAS' Office of Professional Services and Human Capital Categories staff, responsible for strategic leadership, oversight, and management of GSA's professional services, human capital services, and charge card management programs and contracts. PSHC provides assisted acquisition services for FAS customers in Alaska, Idaho, Oregon, and Washington.
Green Buildings:	Twenty buildings are LEED certified – three certifications are LEED Platinum – eight new construction (NC) – 12 existing building (EB)
Small Business Utilization:	In FY 2022, R10 awarded 82.35% of all prime contracts to small businesses. Region 10 also exceeded all socio-economic goals.
Art Program:	57 artworks are currently in GSA Region 10's Fine Arts collection. We recently added five Dale Chihuly artwork pieces in 2022, which were donated in 2017 and currently displayed at Tacoma Union Station.
