Who We Are



- The American Council for Technology-Industry Advisory Council (ACT-IAC) is:
 - Premier public-private partnership in government technology
 - Non-profit educational organization, established to improve government through the application of information technology
 - An objective, trusted, and ethical forum where government and industry can exchange information and collaborate
 - Organized like a coin: one side is ACT and the other is IAC

Who We Are (continued)



- American Council for Technology (ACT)
 - Established in 1979 by government employees to provide a forum for federal, state, and local where government could communicate and collaborate on technology issues
 - Governed by an Executive Committee of senior government executives
 - Sets strategic direction
 - Protects the integrity of the collaborative process
 - Individual membership organization
 - Free to any full-time government employee

Who We Are (continued)



- Industry Advisory Council (IAC)
 - ACT created IAC in 1989 to provide an objective, ethical, and vendor neutral forum where government and industry executives could communicate and collaborate
 - Today, IAC has approximately 500 member companies over 60% are small business
 - Corporate membership organization dues are based on their government revenues
 - Governed by an Executive Committee elected by the IAC membership, that advises and supports the ACT Executive Committee

Our Guiding Principles



- Our mission is better government
 - We strive to improve government outcomes through collaboration and partnership
 - Our activities will be objective, transparent, ethical and vendor/technology neutral
 - Our education programs contribute to a more effective workforce by providing opportunities for government and industry to learn together and from each other
 - We provide an environment of trust that is earned and preserved by not using our activities for sales or lobbying efforts

How We Work



- ACT-IAC activities are outcome based
 - Every program, conference, meeting, and activity is intended to produce outcomes that improve government
 - Every program includes leadership and engagement by both government and industry
 - o Technology is our unifying theme, but not the end game
 - We serve all functional areas including program management, acquisitions, security, finance, human capital and IT
 - We are a volunteer-driven organization our volunteers, from government and industry, lead the organization and create our programs and drive outcomes

 - Approximately 60% of IAC members are small businesses with annual government revenues under \$30 million
- Launched in March 2014, the Small Business Alliance is chartered to promote the interests and contributions of small businesses through programs and events designed to increase engagement and enable a stronger connection with the ACT-IAC community
 - Our goals are to educate and support small business growth, provide programs that provide opportunities to forge partnerships with large businesses, and recognize exceptional small businesses in the information technology community
 - We host Small Business Forums on specific topics (e.g., Category Management, Emerging Technology and Innovation, and Taking the Mystery Out of Certifications) and networking events to promote collaboration
