## **New progress**

- Temporary certificate of occupancy for the new Commercial Building has been received certifying that the fire and life safety systems are fully functional.
- Ongoing Commercial Building punch list activities.
- Ongoing Commercial Building commissioning and near completion.
- Ongoing construction of the retaining wall between Interstate 81 northbound and southbound.
- Phase one exterior lighting is installed and functional.
- Begun drywall and finishing at the new USDA-APHIS Building.
- Begun masonry installation at the new Main Building.
- Progressing landscape rock installation.

#### **Look ahead**

- Substantially complete the new Commercial Building during the month of August.
- Complete final testing of security and access control systems in August.
- Begun planning for re-location of personnel and operational transition.
- Full transition for commercial operations is planned for early September.

### **Project facts**

- **Scope:** Facility-wide modernization and expansion.
- Cost: \$215 million
- Congressional appropriations:
   Phase one funding appropriated in fiscal year 2016 budget.
- Phase two funding appropriated in fiscal year 2018 in the amount of approximately \$133 million.
- **Contract:** Awarded in June 2017 to Northland/Cianbro Joint Venture.

#### **Advisories**


- Strict policies have been put into place to prevent exposure to COVID-19 at the construction site.

# **Project estimated timeline**

- **August 2020 -** Commercial Building substantial completion.
- **September 2020** Complete commercial operational transition.
- **October 2020 -** APHIS Building substantial completion.
- August 2022 Substantial completion of Phase Two.
- **September 2022** Contract completion.
