FAST FACT SHEET: City Pair Program (CPP) FY24 Contract Awards

Participating Airlines

- **Awarded to 8 airlines:** United, American, Delta, Southwest, JetBlue, Hawaiian, Alaska, and Silver Airways

Awarded Markets

- **Awarded 13,391 markets in FY24** (10,398 Domestic and 2,993 International). Represents 90% of all trips flown by government travelers to complete their missions.
- **2,276 markets awarded with Non-stop service**, CPP solicited all eligible non-stop service markets awarding 89.1%.
- The CPP results in **78.6% (or 10,521) of all awards having two discounted coach fares** - this provides flexibility for immediate travel and more deeply discounted fares for booking flights early. The YCA provides last seat availability up until the plane is sold out and the _CA fare offers a deeply discounted offering availability based on supply and demand of a flight.

Savings

- The GSA City Pair Program will continue to save taxpayers an **estimated \$2.42B in FY24**. CPP fares benchmark **53% lower than commercial like fares** with no exchange fees, fully refundable, last seat availability, and no blackout dates.

Good News Story

- City Pair benchmarks lower than corporate airfare in these common routes traveled by the federal government
