

COMMITTEE RESOLUTION

**CONSTRUCTION
U.S. LAND PORT OF ENTRY
CALEXICO, CA
PCA-BSC-CA22**

**RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND PUBLIC WORKS OF THE
UNITED STATES SENATE**

that pursuant to 40 U.S.C. §3307, additional appropriations are authorized for construction of Phase IIB of a two-phase project to reconfigure and expand the existing land port of entry in downtown Calexico, CA at an additional design cost of \$83,000, an additional estimated construction cost of \$3,335,000, and an additional management and inspection cost of \$251,000 for a total additional cost of \$3,669,000, a prospectus for which is attached hereto and included in this resolution.

Provided, that the Administrator shall provide to the Chairman or Ranking Member of the Committee on Environment and Public Works of the Senate, in a timely manner, requested documents and information regarding this prospectus and resulting contractual materials, without redaction other than redactions to exclude business confidential, proprietary, and/or procurement sensitive information.

Provided further, that the General Services Administration shall not delegate to any other agency the authority granted by this resolution.
