

COMMITTEE RESOLUTION

**NEW U.S. COURTHOUSE
CHATTANOOGA, TN
PTN-CTC-CH21**

**RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND PUBLIC WORKS OF THE
UNITED STATES SENATE**

that pursuant to 40 U.S.C. §3307, appropriations are authorized for site acquisition and related work, design, and construction of a new U.S. Courthouse of approximately 186,000 gross square feet, including approximately 39 inside parking spaces, in Chattanooga, TN, at a site cost of \$22,500,000, a design cost of \$17,168,000, an estimated construction cost of \$162,997,000, and a management and inspection cost of \$15,716,000, for a total estimated project cost of \$218,381,000, a prospectus for which is attached hereto and included in this resolution.

Provided, that the Administrator shall provide to the Chairman or Ranking Member of the Committee on Environment and Public Works of the Senate, in a timely manner, requested documents and information regarding this prospectus and resulting contractual materials, without redaction other than redactions to exclude business confidential, proprietary, and/or procurement sensitive information.

Provided further, that the General Services Administration shall not delegate to any other agency the authority granted by this resolution.
