

COMMITTEE RESOLUTION

**ALTERATION
POTTER STEWART U.S. COURTHOUSE
CINCINNATI, OH
POH-0028-CN22**

**RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND PUBLIC WORKS OF THE
UNITED STATES SENATE**

that pursuant to 40 U.S.C. §3307, additional appropriations are authorized for a repair and alteration project for the Potter Stewart U.S. Courthouse, located at 100 East 5TH Street, Cincinnati, OH, to relocate the U.S. Bankruptcy Court (USBC) and upgrade eight passenger elevators and one freight elevator at an additional estimated design cost of \$1,002,000, an additional estimated construction cost of \$9,219,000, and an additional estimated management and inspection cost of \$744,000 for a total additional cost of \$10,965,000, a prospectus for which is attached hereto and included in this resolution. This resolution amends the authorizations of the Committee on May 18, 2016, of Prospectus Number POH-0028-CN16 and June 19, 2019, of Prospectus Number POH-0028-CN19 to account for cost escalation due to time and market conditions.

Provided, that the Administrator shall provide to the Chairman or Ranking Member of the Committee on Environment and Public Works of the Senate, in a timely manner, requested documents and information regarding this prospectus and resulting contractual materials, without redaction other than redactions to exclude business confidential, proprietary, and/or procurement sensitive information.

Provided further, that the General Services Administration shall not delegate to any other agency the authority granted by this resolution.
