ALTERATION PATRICK V. MCNAMARA FEDERAL BUILDING GARAGE DETROIT, MI PMI-0133-DE22

RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND PUBLIC WORKS OF THE UNITED STATES SENATE

that pursuant to 40 U.S.C. §3307, additional appropriations are authorized for a repair and alteration project for the Patrick V. McNamara Federal Building Garage located at 477 Michigan Avenue, Detroit, MI, to complete critical structural and related system upgrades to the parking garage at an additional design cost of \$110,000, an additional construction cost of \$2,879,000, and an additional management and inspection cost of \$74,000 for a total additional cost of \$3,063,000, a prospectus for which is attached hereto and included in this resolution. This resolution amends the authorization of the Committee on February 11, 2020, of Prospectus Number PMI-0133-DE20 to account for cost escalations and inclusion of temporary, off-site leased parking costs for the duration of the project.

Provided, that the Administrator shall provide to the Chairman or Ranking Member of the Committee on Environment and Public Works of the Senate, in a timely manner, requested documents and information regarding this prospectus and resulting contractual materials, without redaction other than redactions to exclude business confidential, proprietary, and/or procurement sensitive information.

Provided further, that the General Services Administration shall not delegate to any other agency the authority granted by this resolution.
