**RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND PUBLIC WORKS OF THE
UNITED STATES SENATE**

that pursuant to 40 U.S.C. §3307, additional appropriations are authorized for repair and alteration projects for the William J. Holloway, Jr. United States Courthouse (Holloway CT) at 200 Northwest Fourth Street, Oklahoma City, OK, and the United States Post Office and Courthouse (PO-CT) at 215 Dean A. McGee Avenue, Oklahoma City, OK, to implement interior alterations, modernization of outdated mechanical, fire alarm, electrical, and plumbing systems, and exterior improvements at an additional design cost of \$1,355,000, an additional estimated construction cost of \$3,922,000, and a reduction in the management and inspection cost of \$605,000 for a total additional cost of \$4,672,000, a prospectus for which is attached hereto and included in this resolution. This resolution amends the authorization of the Committee on December 17, 2019, of Prospectus Number PTX-0046/0072-OK20 to account for cost escalation due to time and market conditions.

Provided, that the Administrator shall provide to the Chairman or Ranking Member of the Committee on Environment and Public Works of the Senate, in a timely manner, requested documents and information regarding this prospectus and resulting contractual materials, without redaction other than redactions to exclude business confidential, proprietary, and/or procurement sensitive information.

Provided further, that the General Services Administration shall not delegate to any other agency the authority granted by this resolution.
