## ALTERATION FEDERAL BUILDING – 801 I STREET SACRAMENTO, CA PCA-0083-SA22

## RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND PUBLIC WORKS OF THE UNITED STATES SENATE

that pursuant to 40 U.S.C. §3307, appropriations are authorized for a repair and alteration project for the Federal Building located at 801 I Street, Sacramento, CA, to backfill vacant space and reconfigure the industrial and historic first floor to improve its utility and accommodate additional future backfill opportunities at a design cost of \$1,235,000, an estimated construction cost of \$11,514,000, and a management and inspection cost of \$836,000 for an estimated total project cost of \$13,585,000, a prospectus for which is attached to and included in this resolution.

*Provided*, that the Administrator shall provide to the Chairman or Ranking Member of the Committee on Environment and Public Works of the Senate, in a timely manner, requested documents and information regarding this prospectus and resulting contractual materials, without redaction other than redactions to exclude business confidential, proprietary, and/or procurement sensitive information.

*Provided further*, that the General Services Administration shall not delegate to any other agency the authority granted by this resolution.
