ALTERATION 301 7th STREET SW REGIONAL OFFICE BUILDING WASHINGTON, DC PDC-0031-WA22

RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND PUBLIC WORKS OF THE UNITED STATES SENATE

that pursuant to 40 U.S.C. §3307, additional appropriations are authorized for repairs and alterations for the Regional Office Building located at 301 7th Street SW, in Washington, DC, to renovate and modernize the building to house the Department of Homeland Security, including upgrades to and replacement of multiple building systems, interior alterations, and exterior repairs, at an additional design cost of \$4,941,000, an additional estimated construction cost of \$82,529,000 and an additional management and inspection cost of \$1,702,000 for a total additional cost of \$89,172,000, a prospectus for which is attached hereto and included in this resolution. This resolution amends the authorization of the Committee on September 30, 2020, of Prospectus No. PDC-0031-WA20 to account for a two-phase approach and request for additional funding.

Provided, that the Administrator shall provide to the Chairman or Ranking Member of the Committee on Environment and Public Works of the Senate, in a timely manner, requested documents and information regarding this prospectus and resulting contractual materials, without redaction other than redactions to exclude business confidential, proprietary, and/or procurement sensitive information.

Provided further, that the General Services Administration shall not delegate to any other agency the authority granted by this resolution.
