ALTERATION ROBERT F. KENNEDY FEDERAL BUILDING WASHINGTON, DC PDC-0023-WA22

Resolved by the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure of the U.S. House of Representatives, that pursuant to 40 U.S.C. §3307, appropriations are authorized for repairs and alterations for the Robert F. Kennedy (RFK) Federal Building located at 950 Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W., Washington, DC. The proposed project will upgrade the 36 passenger elevators and 4 freight elevators in the National Register of Historic Places-listed RFK Federal Building, also known as the Main Justice Building, at a design cost of \$2,793,000, estimated construction cost of \$28,479,000, and management and inspection cost of \$2,267,000, for a total cost of \$33,539,000, a prospectus for which is attached to and included in this resolution.

Provided, that the General Services Administration shall not delegate to any other agency the authority granted by this resolution.

Provided further, not later than 30 calendar days after the date on which a request from the Chair or Ranking Member of the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure of the House of Representatives is received by the Administrator of General Services, the Administrator shall provide such Member a response in writing that provides any information requested regarding the project.

Provided, that the Administrator of General Services shall aim to achieve net zero carbon buildings, if determined by the Administrator to be practical and cost-effective.
