ALTERATION FIRE ALARM SYSTEMS VARIOUS BUILDINGS PFA-0001-MU23

RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND PUBLIC WORKS OF THE UNITED STATES SENATE

that pursuant to title 40 U.S.C. § 3307, a prospectus providing for repair and alteration to upgrade, replace, and improve the fire alarm systems in multiple Government-owned buildings during Fiscal Year 2023 to address critical fire-safety issues at a total cost of \$81,125,000, a prospectus for which is attached to and included in this resolution, is approved.

Provided, that the Administrator shall provide to the Chairman or Ranking Member of the Committee on Environment and Public Works of the Senate, in a timely manner, requested documents and information regarding this prospectus and resulting contractual materials, without redaction other than redactions to exclude business confidential, proprietary, and/or procurement sensitive information.

Provided further, that the General Services Administration shall not delegate to any other agency the authority granted by this resolution.
