CONSTRUCTION DHS CONSOLIDATION AT ST. ELIZABETHS WASHINGTON, DC PDC-0001-WA23

RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND PUBLIC WORKS OF THE UNITED STATES SENATE

that pursuant to title 40 U.S.C. § 3307, a prospectus providing for the continued consolidation and construction of the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) consolidated headquarters (HQ) at the St. Elizabeths Campus, located Washington, DC, at an estimated Historic Preservation cost of \$892,000, an estimated construction cost of \$358,231,000, and an estimated management and inspection cost of \$20,815,000, for a total cost of \$379,938,000, a prospectus for which is attached hereto and included in this resolution, is approved.

Provided, that the Administrator shall provide to the Chairman or Ranking Member of the Committee on Environment and Public Works of the Senate, in a timely manner, requested documents and information regarding this prospectus and resulting contractual materials, without redaction other than redactions to exclude business confidential, proprietary, and/or procurement sensitive information.

Provided further, that the General Services Administration shall not delegate to any other agency the authority granted by this resolution.
