#### Building

Constructed in 1965, the 260,579 gross square foot building was formerly called the National Courts Building but was renamed after Howard T. Markey, the former Chief Judge of the U.S. Court of Customs and Patent Appeals from 1972 to 1982, in 2005. The courthouse building houses the functions of the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit and the Court of Federal Claims. This large building is the core of a complex that includes the Dolley Madison, Tayloe House, and Cosmos Club historical houses, which are all physically connected and operate on a single HVAC system. However, each building is electrically independent and receives power from PEPCO, which is sub-metered.

#### **Proposed Project**

The proposed project will replace the medium voltage service switchgear and medium voltage transformers in the Markey Court Building and the electrical service equipment in the Cosmos Club Building. The project will extend the useful life of the building's electrical system and bring the facility into compliance with applicable codes and standards. Temporary power will also be provided as needed during power outages.

# Justification

The electrical equipment is original to the Howard Markey Court and Cosmos Club buildings. It does not comply with current electrical and safety codes. The obsolete equipment is difficult and expensive to maintain and repair. All the electrical distribution equipment, including the switchgear, network transformers, and switchboard, have exceeded the designated service life for this type of electrical equipment. These obsolete systems increase the risk of unplanned power outages and disruption to tenant missions.

# Summary of Energy, Water, Sustainability, and Climate Risk Compliance

This project will be designed to conform to requirements of *PBS-P100*, *Facilities Standards for the Public Buildings Service*. GSA will focus on design and construction opportunities to increase energy and water efficiencies that minimize operating costs and greenhouse gas emissions, incorporate sustainable design principles into projects, reduce the environmental impact of materials, and address climate risk liabilities in a manner that is life cycle cost effective.
