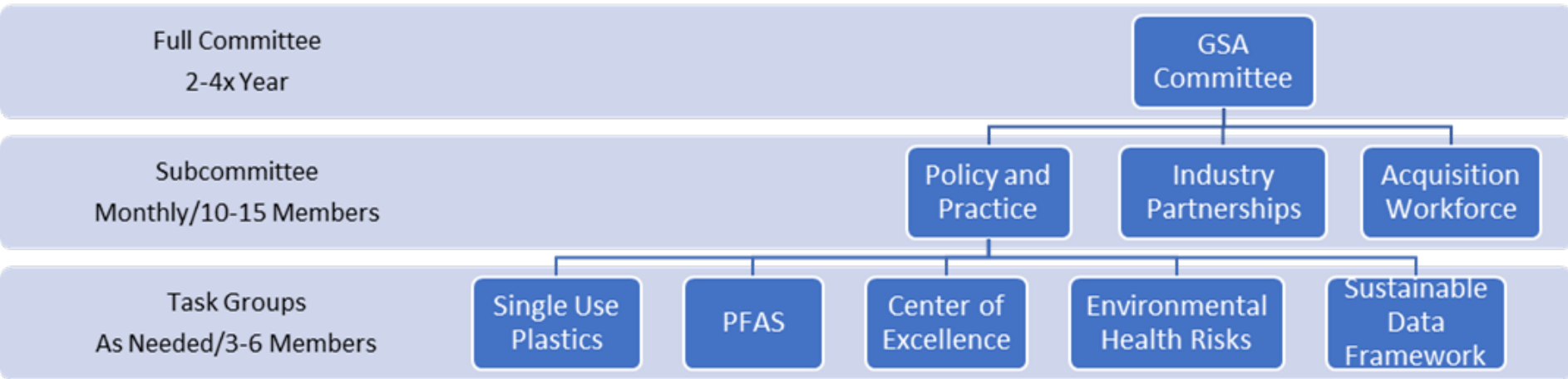
Reaction to Topic Areas

 - How would you propose conducting a deeper dive into these areas in order to be able to make informed recommendations to the GSA?

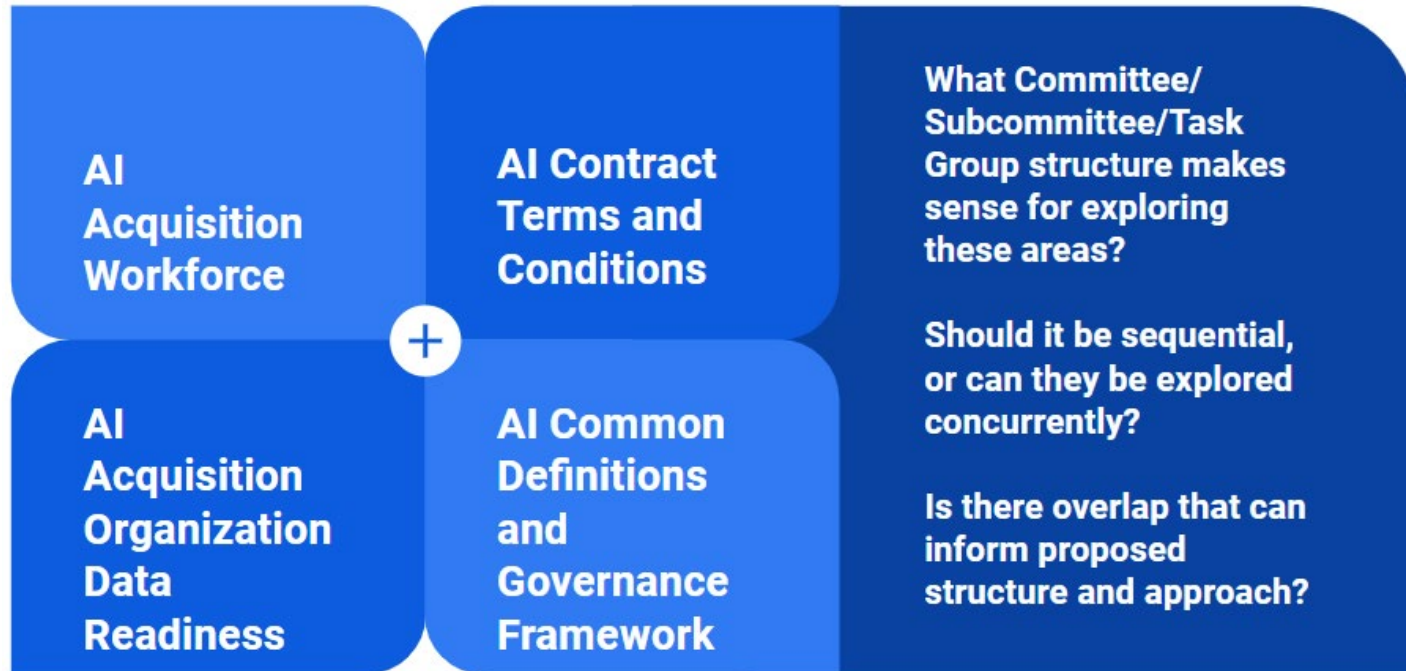
