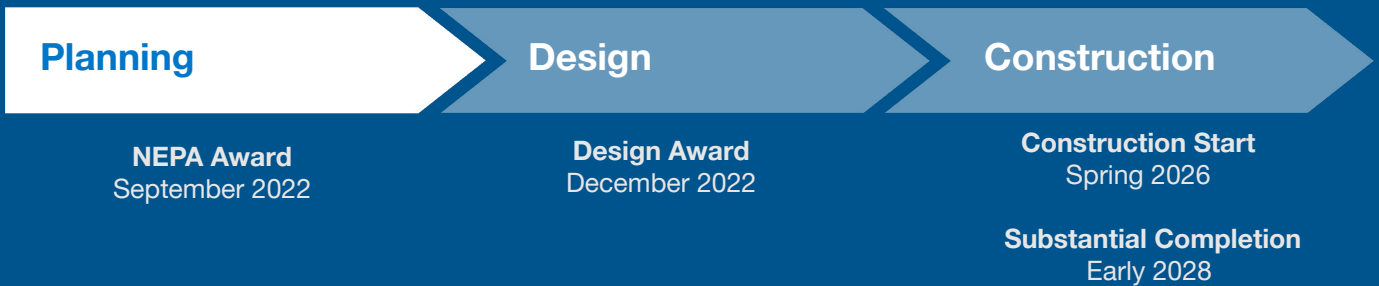
### Project Overview

The current project will design and build a new Land Port of Entry (LPOE) to replace the existing 27-year-old facility. The existing facility is not large enough to handle an expected 30% increase in traffic when construction of Canada Autoroute A-35 is completed.

### Current Status

Design is underway; design concept scheduled for completion in the Fall of 2024. The statements of work for construction manager-as-advisor and construction manager-as-constructor (CMc) services are being developed. The draft of the environmental assessment for NEPA is being prepared.

### Project Timeline



The Bipartisan Infrastructure Law includes \$3.4 billion for GSA to modernize and construct land ports of entry along the nation's borders. These projects will strengthen supply chains, create good-paying jobs, enhance safety and security, and serve as models of sustainability.
