Introduction to the Alliant 2 Governmentwide Acquisition Contract (GWAC)

GSA's Alliant 2 GWAC is a multiple-award, indefinite-delivery/indefinite-quantity (MA-IDIQ) contract offering comprehensive, flexible IT solutions worldwide. Alliant 2 provides best-value information technology (IT) solutions to federal agencies, while strengthening opportunities in federal contracting for small businesses. The Alliant 2 contract has the ambitious goal of 50 percent of all subcontracted work (measured in dollars) being performed by small businesses during the life of the contract.

The scope of Alliant 2 aligns with U.S. Federal Enterprise Architecture, which encompasses all components of an integrated IT solution, including new technologies that may emerge during the life cycle of the contract. This GWAC will provide IT solutions through the performance of a broad range of services that may include the integration of various technologies critical to the services being acquired.

Alliant 2 is Best-in-Class

As a Best-in-Class contract, Alliant 2 is designated by the Office of Management and Budget as a preferred governmentwide solution.

Before issuing orders under Alliant 2, federal Contracting Officers (COs) must:

- Receive training on the use of the Alliant 2 contract
- Be granted a written Delegation of Procurement Authority (DPA) from the GWAC program office
