

Civilian Real Property Alignment

In December 2016, Congress enacted Federal Assets Sale and Transfer Act (FASTA) became law. This bipartisan law seeks to shrink the federal footprint and streamline the disposal of unneeded or underutilized federal buildings.

FASTA Requires

- Establishing a seven member Public Buildings Reform Board (PBRB) to identify candidate properties.
- Through a series of rounds (over 6 yr period) PBRB recommendations reviewed and approved by OMB
- Require the Board to create a website making relevant information accessible to the public;
- GSA to create and publish a single, comprehensive database of all federal real properties.

Status to date

GSA has closed/awarded 9 of the 12 High Value Round assets and is actively marketing the remaining three

- Denver,CO- VA Medical, Menlo Park, CA & Laguna Niguel, CA- Both.GSA
- Round 1 of FASTA was rejected and resubmittal didn't occur due to a lack of quorum of PBRB

Current efforts and proposed initiatives for GSA have to help further the goals of maximizing the efficiency of the federal real property portfolio

• GSA continues to work with OMB and other Land Holding Agencies to advocate for incentives and resources to continue rightsizing the federal government's footprint.
