THIS LEASE, made and entered into this date by and between VERMILION PROPERTIES L.L.C.

and whose interest in the property hereinafter described is that of OWNER

hereinafter called the Lessor, and the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, hereinafter called the Government:

WITNESSETH: The parties hereto for the considerations hereinafter mentioned, covenant and agree as follows:

1. The Lessor hereby leases to the Government the following described premises:

A total of 7,919 rentable square feet (RSF) of office and related space, which yields 6,900 ANSI/BOMA Office Area square feet (USF) of space at 417 Spanish Town Boulevard, New Iberia, Louisiana 70560 to be used for such purposes as determined by the General Services Administration. Included in the rent at no additional cost to the Government are thirty-six (36) parking spaces for exclusive use of Government employees and patrons.

2. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said premises with their appurtenances for the term beginning on 180 working days from the date the Government issues the notice to proceed with Tenant Improvements and continuing for a term of fifteen (15) years subject to termination and renewal rights as may be hereinafter set forth.

3. The Government shall pay the Lessor annual rent as follows:

14. cost e 7,919	In accordance with the SFO paragraph 4.3 entitled Operating Costs, the lease is subject to operating escalation. The escalation base is established as \$4.98/RSF based on \$39,436.62/per annum and RSF.
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- 15. Security costs in the total amount of \$39,123.00 shall be amortized through the rent at \$0.65076/RSF for 120 months at the rate of 5.75%.
- 16. The Lessor shall provide cleaning/maintenance within Tenant's space during tenant working hours, Monday through Friday excluding Federal Holidays.
- 17. The total square footage referred to in paragraph 1, Standard Form 2, is the total amount of space under lease by the Government. If the actual amount of space exceeds 6,900 ANSI/BOMA square feet, there will be no additional cost to the Government. If the actual amount of space is less than 6,900 ANSI/BOMA, the rent will be decreased accordingly.
- 18. In accordance with the SFO Paragraph 2.3 Seismic Safety, a certificate of seismic compliance will be required upon substantial completion of the space. A copy of the seismic certificate with a professional engineer stamp will be required within 30 days of acceptance of the space by the Government.
- 19. In accordance with the SFO Paragraph 2.6 (Broker Commission and Commission Credit), Studley, Inc. ("Studley") is the authorized real estate broker representing GSA in connection with this lease transaction. The Lessor and Studley have agreed to a cooperating lease commission ("Commission"). The total amount of the Commission is awarded and (ii) one-half (1/2) upon the earlier of Tenant's occupancy of the premises leased pursuant to the Lease or the commencement date of the Lease. Due to the Commission Credit described in Paragraph 2.6, only which is of the Commission, will be payable to Studley when the Lease is awarded. The remaining which is of the Commission ("Commission Credit"), shall be credited to the Government as follows:

The shell rental portion of the annual rental payments (\$204,405.31 / 12 months = \$17,033.76 per month) due and owing shall be reduced to fully recapture this Commission Credit. The reduction in shell rent shall commence with the first full month of the rental payment and continue through the fourth full month of the lease term as indicated in the following schedule of adjusted Monthly Rent:

First full month payment of \$23,427.04 minus prorated Commission Credit of Month 1: equals adiusted First Month's Rent. Month 2: Second full month payment of \$23,427.04 minus prorated Commission Credit of equals adjusted Second Month's Rent. Third full month payment of\$23,427.04 minus prorated Commission Credit of Month 3: adjusted Third Month's Rent. equals Fourth full month payment of\$23,427.04 minus prorated Commission Credit of Month 4: equals adjusted Fourth Month's Rent

- 20. Per the Debt Collection Improvement Act, effective July 27, 1996, Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) shall be required on all existing and new lease contracts after January 1, 1998. An enrollment form is attached to be completed and returned with this contract.
- 21. All questions pertaining to this Lease shall be referred to the Contracting Officer of General Services Administration (GSA) or their designee. The Government occupant **is not** authorized to administer this lease, and GSA assumes no responsibility for any cost incurred by the Lessor except as provided by the terms of this Lease or authorized **in writing** by Contracting Officer or their designee. The Lessor will not be reimbursed for any services not provided for in this Lease, including but not limited to: repairs, alterations and overtime services. Additionally, rental will not be paid for occupancy in whole or in part except for the term specified herein.

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
