WITNESSETH: The parties hereto for the consideration hereinafter mentioned, covenant and agree as follows:

The Lessor hereby leases to the Government the following described premises:

Approximately 10,741 ANSI/BOMA Office Area square feet (USF) of office and related space, which yields 11,172 rentable square feet (RSF) of space located at the John Hanson Business Center, 339 Busch's Frontage Road, Annapolis, MD 21409-5543 to be used for such purposes as may be determined by the U.S. General Services Administration. Included in the rent at no additional cost to the Government are 15 reserved parking spaces for the general use of Government employees and patrons. These parking spaces shall be located in the adjacent surface parking lot for the building.
