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SECTION 1 THE PREMISES, RENT, AND OTHER TERMS

1.01 THE PREMISES (SUCCEEDING) (SEPT 2011)

Unless otherwise noted, the Government accepts the lessed premises and tenant improvements in their current existing condition, with the following exceptions further outlined more theroughly in this lesse. These exceptions include, but are not limited to, security improvements. Fire Protection and Life Safety requirements, ABAAS compilance, as well as compilance with all local codes and ordinances. The Lessor shall be responsible for continuing obligations for cleaning, janitotial, maintenance, repair, etc. as set forth in the lesse paragraphs and attached General Clauses.

The Premises are described as follows:

Office and Related Space: 7,277 rentable square feet (RSF), yielding 6,290 ANSI/BCMA Office Area (ABOA) square feet of office and related space based upon a Common Area Factor of 15.7%, located on the 3st and 4th floors and known as Suites 303 and 402, respectively, of the Building.

1.02 EXPRESS APPURTENANT RIGHTS (SEPT 2011)

The Government shall have the non-exclusive right to the use of Appurtenent Areas, and shall have the right to post Government Rules and Regulations within such areas. The Government will coordinate with the Lessor's standards, Appurtenent to the Premises and included with the Lessor's standards, appurtenent to the Premises and included with the Lessor are rights to use the following:
