SECTION 1 THE PREMISES, RENT, AND OTHER TERMS

1.01 THE PREMISES—SUCCEEDING (APR 2011)

Unless otherwise noted, the Government accepts the leased premises and tenant improvements in their current existing condition, with the following exceptions further outlined more thoroughly in this solicitation. These exceptions include, but are not limited to, security improvements, National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) requirements, ABAAS compliance, as well as compliance with all local codes and ordinances.
