WHEREAS, the parties hereto desire to amend the above Lease to authorize various repairs to the paper and sugar labs HVAC system, and water quality improvement at five eyewash stations at the leased premises.

NOW THEREFORE, these parties for the consideration hereinafter mentioned covenant and agree that the said Lease is amended, . IN ACCORDANCE

- WITH EXHIBIT 1. The Lessor shall at the Lessor's sole cost and expense provide all labor, materials, permits, and installation necessary to complete the repairs to the paper and sugar labs HVAC system, including but not limited to replacement of the manifold and three valves as set forth in the December 15, 2006 proposal and cut sheets, attached hereto as Exhibit A. The Lessor agrees to complete this work to the satisfaction of the Government no later than March 31, 2007.
- 2. Upon the Government's acceptance of the work listed in Exhibit A as complete, the Lessor shall submit an invoice, in proper form no later than May 31, 2007, to the Government, whereupon the Government shall make a one time, lump-sum payment to the Lessor for a total not to exceed \$6,870.38, as payment in full for the work listed in Exhibit A. The itemized invoice in proper form, shall contain the Lessor's certification of Celiano labor hours actually worked which are quoted in the Celiano December 14, 2006 proposal as not to exceed 48 hours, and Newark Center Building Company hours actually worked which are quoted in the December 15, 2006 proposal as 4 hours.
- 3. The Lessor shall at the Lessor's sole cost and expense provide all labor, materials, permits, and installation necessary to improve water quality at five eyewash stations, including but not limited to installation of in-line filtration, as set forth in the October 23, 2006 proposal, attached hereto as Exhibit B. The Lessor agrees to complete this work to the satisfaction of the Government no later than March 31, 2007. nan March 31, 2007.

The itemized invoice in proper form shall contain the Lessor's certification of Celiano labor hours actually worked which are quoted in the Celiano October 16, 2006 proposal as not to exceed 26 hours, and Newark Center Building Company hour actually worked which is quoted in the October 23, 2006 proposal as 1 hour.
- 5. For the lump-sum payments authorized in this SLA #47, the Pegasys Document Number is PS0009723. The Lessor must cite this Pegasys Document Number on the invoice and submit the original invoice to General Services Administration, Finance Division -7BCP, 819 Taylor Street, Fort Worth, TX 76102-0181.
