## **LEASE TERM**

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# SECTION 1 THE PREMISES, RENT, AND OTHER TERMS

## 1.01 THE PREMISES (AUG 2011)

The Premises are described as follows:

Office and Related Space: 5,343 rentable square feet (RSF), yielding 4,646 ANSI/BOMA Office Area (AI3OA) square feet of office and related space, located on the 1st floor(s), of the Building, as depicted on the floor plan(s) attached hereto as Exhibit A.

## 1.02 EXPRESS APPURTENANT RIGHTS (AUG 2011)

The Government shall have the non-exclusive right to the use of Appurtenant Areas, and shall have the right to post Government Rules and Regulations within such areas. The Government will coordinate with the Lessor to ensure signage is consistent with the Lessor's standards. Appurtenant to the Premises and included with the Lease are rights to use the following:

- A. <u>Parking</u>: Seven (7) parking spaces shall be surface spaces for the exclusive use of the Government. In addition, the Lessor shall provide such additional parking spaces as required by the applicable code of the local government entity having jurisdiction over the Property. In the absence of a local code requirement, on-site parking shall be available at a ratio of one (1) space for every 1,000 RSF of Government-demised area.
- B. <u>Antennas, Satellite Dishes, and Related Transmission Devices</u>: Space located on the roof of the Building sufficient in size for the installation and placement of the telecommunications equipment as such may be described herein, together with the right to access the roof and use of, all building areas (e.g., chases, plenums) necessary for the use, operation and maintenance of such equipment at all times during the term of this Lease.

# 1.03 RENT AND OTHER CONSIDERATION (AUG 2011)

A. The Government shall pay the Lessor annual rent, payable monthly installments in arrears, at the following rates:

- B. Rent is subject to adjustment based upon a physical mutual measurement of the Space upon acceptance, not to exceed 4,646 ABOA SF based upon the methodology outlined under the "Payment" clause of GSA Form 3517B.
- C. Rent is subject to adjustment based upon the final Tenant Improvement (TI) cost to be amortized in the rental rate, as agreed upon by the parties subsequent to the Lease Award Date.
- D. If the Government occupies the Premises for less than a full calendar month, then rent shall be prorated based on the actual number of days of occupancy for that month.
- E. Rent shall be paid to the Lessor by electronic funds transfer in accordance with the provisions of the General Clauses. Rent shall be payable to the Payee designated in the Lessor's Central Contractor Registration.
- F. The Lessor shall provide to the Government, in exchange for the payment of rental and other specified consideration, the following:
  - 1. The leasehold interest in the Property described in "Paragraph 1.01 THE PREMISES" created herein;
- 2. All costs, expenses and fees to perform the work required for acceptance of the Premises in accordance with this Lease, including all costs for labor, materials, and equipment, professional fees, contractor fees, attorney fees, permit fees, inspection fees, and similar such fees, and all related expenses;
  - 3. Performance or satisfaction of all other obligations set forth in this Lease; and
- 4. All services, utilities, and maintenance required for the proper operation of the Property, the Building, and the Premises in accordance with the terms of the Lease, including, but not limited to, all inspections, modifications, repairs, replacements, and improvements required to be made thereto to meet the requirements of this Lease.

# 1.04 BROKER COMMISSION AND COMMISSION CREDIT (AUG 2011)

A. CBRE, Inc. ("Broker") is the authorized real estate Broker representing GSA in connection with this lease transaction. The total amount of the Commission is and is earned upon lease execution, payable according to the Commission Agreement signed between the two parties. Only of the Commission, will be payable to CBRE, Inc. with the remaining which is the "Commission Credit", to be credited to the shell rental portion of the annual rental payments due and owing to fully recapture this Commission Credit. The reduction in shell rent shall commence with the first month of the rental payments and continue until the credit has been fully recaptured in equal monthly installments over the shortest time practicable.

B. Notwithstanding the "Rent and Other Consideration" paragraph of this Lease, the shell rental payments due and owing under this lease shall be reduced to recapture fully this Commission Credit. The reduction in shell rent shall commence with the first month of the rental payments and continue as indicated in this schedule for adjusted Monthly Rent: NOT APPLICABLE

#### 1.05 TERMINATION RIGHTS (AUG 2011)

The Government may terminate this Lease, in whole or in parts, at any time on or after the fifth full year of occupancy of this Lease by providing not less than (90) ninety calendar days' prior written notice to the Lessor. The effective date of the termination shall be the day following the expiration of the required notice period or the termination date set forth in the notice, whichever is later. No rental shall accrue after the effective date of termination.

### 1.08 TENANT IMPROVEMENTS AND PRICING (STREAMLINED) (SEPT 2011)

TENANT IMPROVEMENT PRICING BASED ON TENANT IMPROVEMENT ALLOWANCE (TIA) (STREAMLINED) (JUL 2011)

The Tenant Improvement Allowance (TIA) for purposes of this Lease is \$41.00 per ABOA SF. The TIA is the amount that the Lessor shall make available for the Government to be used for the TIs. This amount is amortized in the rent over the firm term of this Lease at an annual interest rate of 6.5% percent.

- A. The Government, at its sole discretion, shall make all decisions as to the use of the TIA. The Government may use all or part of the TIA. The Government may return to the Lessor any unused portion of the TIA in exchange for a decrease in rent according to the agreed-upon amortization rate over the firm term.
- B. The Government shall have the right to make lump sum payments for any or all work covered by the TIA. That part of the TIA amortized in the rent shall be reduced accordingly. At any time after occupancy and during the firm term of the Lease, the Government, at its sole discretion, may choose to pay lump sum for any part or all of the remaining unpaid amortized balance of the TIA. If the Government elects to make a lump sum payment for the TIA after occupancy, the payment of the TIA by the Government will result in a decrease in the rent according to the amortization rate over the firm term of the Lease.
- C. If it is anticipated that the Government will spend more than the allowance identified above, the Government shall have the right to either
  - Reduce the TI requirements.
  - Pay lump sum for the overage upon completion and acceptance of the improvements.
  - Increase the rent according to the negotiated amortization rate over the firm term of the Lease.

### 1.11 PERCENTAGE OF OCCUPANCY FOR TAX ADJUSTMENT, ESTABLISHMENT OF TAX BASE (AUG 2011)

As of the Lease Award Date, the Government's Percentage of Occupancy, as defined in the "Real Estate Tax Adjustment" clause of this lease is 100 percent. The percentage of occupancy is derived by dividing the total Government space of 5,343 RSF by the total building space of 5,343 rentable square feet.

The real estate tax base, as defined in the "Real Estate Tax Adjustment" clause of the Lease is \$XX.

### 1.12 OPERATING COST BASE (AUG 2011)

The parties agree that for the purpose of applying the clause titled "Operating Costs Adjustment Included in Offer" that the Lessor's base rate for operating costs shall be \$4.32 per rentable sq. ft (\$23,081.76/annum).

#### 1.13 RATE FOR ADJUSTMENT FOR VACANT LEASED PREMISES (AUG 2011)

In accordance with the section entitled "Adjustment for Vacant Premises" if the Government fails to occupy or vacates the entire or any portion of the Leased Premises prior to expiration of the term of the Lease, the operating costs paid by the Government as part of the rent shall be reduced by \$2.76 per ABOA SF of space vacated by the Government.

### 1.14 HOURLY OVERTIME HVAC RATES (AUG 2011)

The following rates shall apply in the application of the clause titled "Overtime HVAC Usage:"

# 1.15 24-HOUR HVAC REQUIREMENT (APR 2011)

The Hourly Overtime HVAC rate specified above shall not apply to any portion of the Premises that is required to have heating and cooling 24 hours per day. If 24-hour HVAC is required by the Government for any designated rooms or areas of the Premises, such services shall be provided by the Lessor at an annual rate of \$0.00 per ABOA SF of the area receiving the 24-hour HVAC. Lessor shall provide this service at no additional cost to the Government if the Lessor provides this service to other tenants in the Building at no additional charge.

## 1.16 ADDITIONAL BUILDING IMPROVEMENTS (AUG 2011)

In addition to construction of the TIs as required in this Lease, the Lessor shall be required to complete the following additional building improvements (e.g., Fire Protection and Life Safety, Seismic, and Energy Efficiency) prior to acceptance of the Space:

- A. Replace door leading from garage to interior space with ABAAS compliant door that is fire proof with weather stripping/caulking applied
- B. Repair or replace gutter above garage person-entry door.
- C. Ensure vestibule area is ABAAS compliant
- D. Repair or replace HVAC throughout space to maintain temperature range referenced in paragraph 6.04 of this Lease.
- E. Clean or replace tile flooring in both restrooms
- F. Caulk or apply weather stripping in draft prone areas identified by the Government tenant. Materials used shall be low in volatile organic compounds
- G. Inspect and replace stained ceiling tiles throughout entire space. Investigate cause of stains and make repairs that will prevent future staining.
- H. Provide quarterly replacement of filters of the HVAC unit.
- Replace non-working batteries in emergency lighting. Ensure emergency testing is added to maintenance schedule.

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
