Project Overview

The overall project entails Repair & Alteration (R&A) of the existing Land Port Of Entry (LPOE) facility. Repairs include: expanded inbound and outbound canopy, enclosed vehicle search area, soft secondary inspection canopy, employee parking, and interior renovation of existing facility to meet updated Customs and Border Protection (CBP) program of requirements.

Current Status

Architect / engineer services were awarded to Marble Fairbanks in October 2023. The Construction Manager as Advisor was awarded in April 2024. Three-phase power and geothermal heat studies are complete. The concept design phase is currently underway.
