

ONE ACQUISITION SOLUTION FOR INTEGRATED SERVICES (OASIS) ORDER ONE PAGE CHECKLIST

How to issue an order under OASIS

- Determine the <u>OASIS NAICS code</u> representing the principle purpose of your requirement. This will determine the OASIS (U, SB or 8(a)) Pool to compete under.
- Issue order Solicitation under the determined Pool. <u>Symphony</u> was designed to ensure fair opportunity requirements under <u>FAR 16.505(b)(1)</u>. <u>FAR 52.216-19</u> Minimum order limitation is the SAT (contractor discretion for < SAT). There is no maximum order limit.
 - **Order Solicitations** (Use <u>FAR 16.505</u> ordering procedures)
 - Include Statement of Work (SOW), evaluation criteria and type of order (*i.e.*, Commercial or Non-Commercial, firm fixed price, labor-hour, time-and-materials, cost reimbursement, or hybrid).
 - See FAR 16.301-3 for cost reimbursement orders FAR 16.505(b)(4).
 - See <u>FAR 16.601</u> for time-and-material or labor-hour orders <u>FAR 16.505(b)(5)</u>.
 - Use OASIS Unrestricted (U) for unrestricted orders not set-aside to small business.
 - Use OASIS Small Business (SB) for orders set-aside to small business.
 - Orders under OASIS SB may be set-aside for socioeconomic competition (e.g, SDVOSB only competition) FAR 16.505(b)(2)(i)(F).
 - State your socioeconomic set aside in the Solicitation
 - Use OASIS 8A Pools for all orders (competitive or Sole Source) under the 8(a) program.
- 3. Evaluate offers and make award in accordance with your solicitation evaluation criteria.
 - Document award decision FAR 16.505(b)(7).
 - Award order to successful offeror (must reference OASIS contract number).
 - Provide notice to unsuccessful offerors.
 - For orders exceeding \$5.5 million, see post award notice and debriefing procedures FAR 16.505(b)(6).
 - Provide completed <u>OASIS Ordering Guide Appendix C</u> and complete copy of Task order to <u>OASISAWARDS@gsa.gov</u> within 5 days after Task Order award.
 - When reporting in FPDS, ensure order references the OASIS Contract number.
- 4. Sam.gov notice of award not required except as detailed in FAR 5.301(a)(2)
- 5. No protests allowed for orders valued up to \$10 million FAR 16.505(a)(10)(i)(B)(1)
