PART I - SOLICITATION/DESCRIPTION OF REQUIREMENTS (To be completed by Government)

A. REQUIREMENTS

 The Government of the United States of America is seeking to lease 16 (sixteen) surface parking spaces for occupancy not later than May 1, 2015, for a term of 10 (ten) years, 5 (five) years firm.

3. INITIAL OFFERS ARE DUE ON OR BEFORE 5:00PM EST ON JANUARY 9, 2015.

B. STANDARD CONDITIONS AND REQUIREMENTS

- 4. The following standard conditions and requirements shall apply to any premises offered for lease to the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA (the GOVERNMENT):
- a. The Government may terrainate this Lease, in whole or in part, after the Firm Term of this Lease by providing not less than 120 calendar days prior written notice to the Lessor. The effective date of the termination shall be the day following the expiration of the required notice period or the termination date set forth in the notice, whichever is later. No rental shall accrue after the effective date of termination.
- b. The Lessor shall provide a valid Certificate of Occupancy, if applicable, for the Intended use of the Government and shall meet, maintain, and operate the building in conformance with all applicable current (as of the date of this solicitation) codes and ordinances.
- c. Offered space shall meet or be upgraded to meet the applicable egress requirements in National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) 101, Life Safety Code or an VISTIS alternative approach or method for achieving a level of safety deemed equivalent and acceptable by the Government.
- d. The leased Space and areas serving the leased Space shall be accessible to persons with disabilities in accordance with the Architectural Barriers Act Accessibility Standard (ABAAS), Appendices C and D to 36 CFR Part 1191 (ABA Chapters 1 and 2, and Chapters 3 through 10). To the extent the standard referenced in the proceeding sentence conflicts with local accessibility requirements, the more stringent shall apply.
- 2. The leased space shall be free of all asbestos containing materials, except undamaged asbestos flooring in the space or undamaged boiler or pipe insulation outside the space, in which case an asbestos management program conforming to Environmental Protection Agency guidance shall be implemented. The space shall be free of other hazardous materials and in compliance with applicable Federal, State, and local environmental laws and regulations.
- f. Services, utilities, and maintenance will be provided daily, extending from 7:00am-6:00nm; except Saturdays, Sundays, and Federal Holidays. The Government shall have necess to the leased space at all times, 24 hours a day, 365 days a year, including the use of electrical services, without additional payment.
- h. The Offeror must have an active registration in the Central Contractor Registration (CCR) System (via the Internet at http://www.ccr.gov) prior to lease award and throughout the life of the lease. To remain active, the Lessor must update or renew its registration annually. The Government will not process rent payments to Lessors without an active CCR Registration. The Government will recognize no change of ownership of the leased premises until the new owner registers in the CCR system.

6. OTHER REQUIREMENTS

- The Lessor shall not post sign(s) or otherwise identify the facility and parking areas as a Government, or specific Government tenant, occupied facility without written Government approval.
- Lessor is responsible to remove unauthorized vehicles parked in Government spaces.
- III. Snow Removal: Lessor shall provide snow removal services for the Government. Lessor shall clear purking lots if the accumulation of snow exceeds two inches. Lessor shall clear sidewalks, walkways and other parking lot entrances before accumulation exceeds 1,3 inches. The snow removal shall take place no later than 5.00 AM, without exception. Should accumulation continue throughout the day, the Lessor shall provide such additional snow removal services to prevent accumulation greater than the maximums specified in this paragraph. In addition to snow removal, the Lessor shall keep the parking lot free of ice. The Lessor shall remove excess buildup of sand and/or ice melt to minimize slipping hazards.
- IV. Lighting: Parking Structures: The minimum illuminance level for purking structures is 5 foot enables as measured on the floor with a uniformity ratio of TP, 10:1.
 - V. The Government shall have access to the leased premises 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.
