

COMMITTEE RESOLUTION

ALTERATION RALPH H. METCALFE FEDERAL BUILDING CHICAGO, IL PIL-0303-FY25


RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND PUBLIC WORKS OF THE UNITED STATES SENATE

that pursuant to title 40 U.S.C. § 3307, a prospectus providing for a repair and alteration project for the Ralph H. Metcalfe Federal Building located at 77 W. Jackson Boulevard, Chicago, Illinois, to optimize the utilization of space and correct major building deficiencies, relocate the Railroad Retirement Board to the Ralph H. Metcalfe Federal Building from the Lipinski Federal Building, and upgrade the Ralph H. Metcalfe Federal Building's heating, ventilation, and air conditioning, electrical, conveyance, plumbing and fire protection systems, and improve building common services including the conference center, for an estimated total project cost of \$162,207,000, a description of which is attached hereto and by reference made part of this resolution, is approved. This prospectus amends Prospectus No. PIL-0303-FY21.

Provided further, that the Administrator shall provide to the Chairman or Ranking Member of the Committee on Environment and Public Works of the Senate, in a timely manner, requested documents and information regarding this prospectus and resulting contractual materials, without redaction other than redactions to exclude business confidential, proprietary, and/or procurement sensitive information.

Provided further, that the Administrator shall not delegate to any other agency the authority granted by this resolution.
